

Turf/Dirt Relationships

AEROBIC STEPPER is a prime example of the accurate relationship between turf and dirt numbers. This horse is also a nice example of a recovery line.

Last year, STEPPER ran a 12" on it's 1st turf effort - an 8 point top! However, her next two dirt starts were right in line with her other dirt starts. She even ran a new dirt top of 18" soon afterwards. This shows that the 12" wasn't as much a huge new top as an indication of her true turf ability.

1st out this year, she paired up her dirt top then bounced a few points to that 21". She started a recovery with her next start of 19". Then, after a little rest she's back on the turf at 18-1.

The race she was in was competitive. There was a strong favorite that was probable to run a 13 or a little better. The other contenders were a notch slower – but most had solid patterns.

At the price, AEROBIC STEPPER was a very nice overlay and a very strong play. The favorite ran 2nd for a \$100+ exacta.
